## U.S. Shipping Corp Receives Environmental Achievement Awards from the Chamber of Shipping of America

EDISON, N.J., November 4, 2015 -- The Chamber of Shipping of America (CSA) presented four U.S. Shipping Corp (U.S. Shipping) vessels with Environmental Achievement Awards at a ceremony in Washington, D.C.

The CSA presents Environmental Achievement Awards annually to manned merchant vessels which have operated for two years or more without a reportable spill, a violation of MARPOL cited by the U.S. Coast Guard or a port state, or a violation of local or state pollution regulations.

U.S. Shipping's articulated tug barge (ATB) Freeport has met the CSA's standards for eight years, ATB Galveston for seven years, ATB Brownsville for six years, and tanker ship Charleston for two years.
