## U.S. Shipping Corp Receives Jones F. Devlin Awards for Safety from the Chamber of Shipping of America

EDISON, N.J., June 8, 2016 -- The Chamber of Shipping of America (CSA) presented six U.S. Shipping Corp (U.S. Shipping) vessels with Jones F. Devlin Awards for safety at an awards luncheon.

The Devlin Awards are presented annually by the CSA to manned merchant vessels which have operated for two years or more without a crew member losing a full turn at watch due to an occupational injury.

U.S. Shipping's articulated tug barge Freeport and tanker ship Houston have met the CSA's standard for eight years, ATB Brownsville for seven years, ATB Corpus Christi for six years, and tanker ships Chemical Pioneer and Charleston for three years.
