Four U.S. Shipping Vessels Receive CSA Environmental Achievement Awards

Four U.S. Shipping vessels – the ATBs *Brownsville*, *Corpus Christi*, *Freeport* and *Galveston* – were awarded Chamber of Shipping of America (CSA) Environmental Achievement Awards for 2014, at a dinner ceremony held in November in Washington, D.C. The awards are given to vessels that have operated for two years or longer without reportable spills, MARPOL violations (as cited by the Coast Guard or a port state), and violations of state or local pollution regulations.

The *Brownsville* and the *Corpus Christi* have maintained their clean records for five years; the *Galveston*, six years; and the *Freeport*, seven years.
